

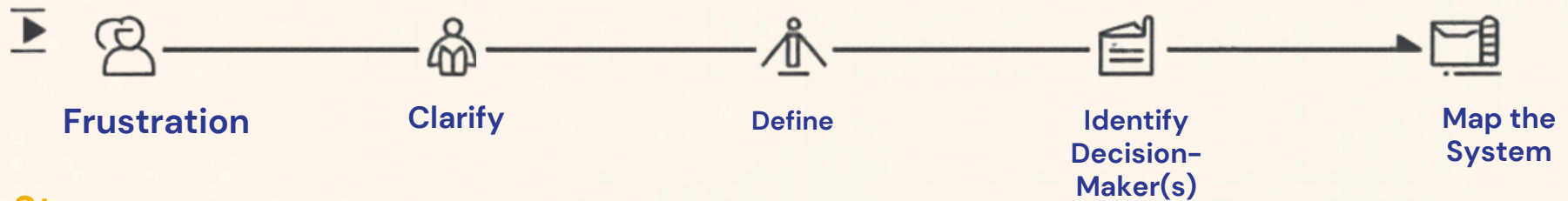



Frustration

A repeated barrier is a signal, not a failure.

Steps

1. Clarify

- What is happening?
- Who is impacted?
- What facts/evidence exists?

2. Define

What specific outcome would resolve the issue?
(i.e. motion, resolution, policy, program)

3. Identify Decision-Maker

Who has authority to act?

4. Map the System

- Who influences the decision?
- Who implements it?

5. Frame the Issue

Align with priorities: access, equity, compliance, accountability

6. Build

Engage partners, families, organizations, internal champions

7. Act

Take action through formal channels

8. Accountability

Track progress and ensure follow-through
